## Employment Nelson-Tasman

### Introduction

The health services industry includes a broad range of health care providers. The main services are mental health, health, and elderly care. Health services have a strong focus towards community-based rehabilitation and develop programmes to help prevent and overcome illness, which means an increasing number of providers are working in schools, community clinics and private practice.

### Employment in the Industry

This sector employed over 3000 in the year 2000.

- ◆ **Public Hospitals** are one of the larger employers in the health and community industry. Nelson Marlborough Health employs 2500 people in Nelson - Blenheim.
- ◆ **Community Support** services require people to have life skills and maturity to work with people in disability, mental health, and elder care.
- ◆ **Health Service Practitioners** develop ongoing therapeutic programmes to help people (and often their families) overcome their illnesses, and play a major part in educating clients on how to help themselves prevent injuries and long-term health problems.
- ◆ **Community Services** - There is a wide variety of different areas in community service and much of this is provided by volunteers. People working in the community service sectors have a primary focus of working with their clients to improve their quality of life. Qualifications needed to enter these jobs vary widely, from the post-tertiary degree and registration needed to work as a clinical psychologist, to the training and life experience required for career counselling.
- ◆ **Pharmacy** is concerned with the preparation and use of medicines and their effect on the human body. The three main categories of pharmacy are hospital, industrial and community. New Zealand Pharmacists and pharmacy technicians are welcomed in Australia, the United Kingdom and the United States.
- ◆ **Elderly Care** – New Zealand has an aging population and a number of people choose to retire in Nelson. This will mean more people will be needed to provide care for the elderly.
- ◆ **Personal Health** and fitness is becoming more and more popular increasing the need for personal trainers.
- ◆ **Specialists** – Qualified health specialists are highly valued.

### What Employers Are Looking For

- ◆ To have compassion, and an interest in caring for people is important.
- ◆ A strong belief in the importance of health and well being is needed.
- ◆ Health providers need to have skill and qualifications relevant to their area of work.

### Current Skill Shortages

- ◆ There is a shortage of nursing staff nationwide, particularly Registered Nurses.
- ◆ Care givers and kitchen assistants for elderly care.
- ◆ Support workers in the community working for the Hospital.
