TIPS FOR RECYCLING:

- **GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS**—rinse out and place straight in your bin.
- **PAPER**—put into a plastic shopping bag (to stop it blowing away).
- **PLASTIC 1 - 7 (EXCLUDING STYROFOAM)**—rinse out and put straight into your bin. Please remove caps from all fizzy drink bottles.
- **ALUMINIUM/METAL CANS**—rinse out and put straight into your bin.
- **CARDBOARD**—fold, tie and place on top of your bin.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

CAN I GET AN EXTRA OR REPLACEMENT BLUE BIN?

Yes—they are available from Nelmac and Nelson City Council for a small fee.

WHAT IF I CAN'T REMEMBER WHICH WEEK WE'RE UP TO?

The Calendar (on the reverse of this card) shows how the recycling collection service alternates. Pop it on your fridge as a reminder.

WHAT IF I PUT OUT THE WRONG MATERIAL ON THE WRONG WEEK?

A calendar will be placed in your Blue Bin to remind you. The material will not be picked up.

HOLIDAY COLLECTION CHANGES FOR RUBBISH AND RECYCLING:

Good Friday's collection will be Saturday 30th March.

For all other public holidays collection is as usual.
